

EQUALIZATION BOARD MEMBERS

§26-27-307. Secretary of board.

The clerk of the county court or the clerk's designee shall serve as secretary of the equalization board of the clerk's county and shall keep a complete and accurate journal of its proceedings and perform such other duties as may be by law required of the board. In addition, within ten (10) days after the appointment of the equalization board for the clerk's county, the clerk or the clerk's designee shall file from time to time with the Assessment Coordination Department a statement showing the name and address of each member of the board. When any change in the personnel of the board is made, the clerk shall immediately so advise the commission.
