MINUTES

The October 13, 2011, minutes were presented to the Board. Dr. Barnett moved to accept the minutes. Mr. McCoy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

BUDGET REPORT

The budget report was presented to the Board. The report included the monthly report from the Office of Budget showing an available budget of \$83,115.06 on 12/1/2011. The office register report of the money management trust fund balance is at \$98,932.72. Dr. Barnett moved to accept the budget report. Dr. Traylor-Logan seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Taylor asked Ms. Wright to have an updated of the MMTF research available for the January 2012 meeting.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA) REQUESTS REPORT

The FOIA requests report was presented to the Board. The report shows that from July 2011 to current, six (6) requests were received.

Continuing Education (CE) Report

The CE report was presented to the Board. The report shows that in 2011, 545 courses were processed and 538 were approved for the 2011 and 2012 calendar years. A total of \$13, 753.75 was received.

Ms. Wright stated that she would provide a comparison of years past at the January 2012 meeting.

2012 License Renewal Report

The 2012 license renewal report was presented to the Board. The report shows that 124 renewals have been processed and a total of \$23,700.00 has been received.

OLD BUSINESS

Document Imaging Software

Ms. Wright presented to the Board a follow-up discussion of the document imaging software information. Discussion followed. Dr. Moore moved that the office wait a year and revisit the issue. Mr. McCoy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

License Renewal Period

Ms. Wright presented to the Board information of the 50 U.S. States license renewal period. The Board discussed if it would like to change the Arkansas renewal period. Discussion followed. Mr. McCoy moved to table the discussion and to talk to other States at the May FCLB annual conference. Dr. Butler seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE) – Part III Test Committee

The NBCE inquired if an Arkansas representative would like to participate in the Part III test committee scheduled for February 2012. Discussion followed. Mr. McCoy moved to approve Dr. Butler to represent Arkansas. Mr. Roberts seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Traylor Chiropractic Clinics – Sale of Corporation

Dr. M.M. Traylor is deceased and the sale of the corporation has been delayed. There are two doctors currently working for the corporation. Discussion followed. Mr. Roberts moved to waive the requirement of professional ownership until Dr. Traylor's estate is settled. Mr. McCoy seconded the motion. Dr. Traylor-Logan abstained. The motion passed.
