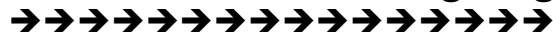


Welcome the Children Training Registration

Dates and Training Topics (Please try to attend both days - check dates you plan to attend)

- Tuesday, September 22, 2009 - Core Module 1 Cultural Diversity** - This session covers recognition and acceptance of cultural and linguistic diversity, with an emphasis on Latin American culture. Information will be presented on cultural similarities and differences pertaining to family, communication, observance of holidays, health practices, and child care.
- Wednesday, September 23, 2009 - Core Module 2 - Second Language Development and Working with Families** (of Spanish-Speaking Children Learning English as a Second Language) - This session covers the first and second language acquisition process for young children, language difference vs. language delay, strategies for working with children not fluent in English, and working with interpreters.

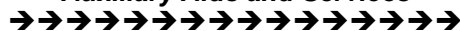
