In addition, the Board chose to change the written exams to a computer-based testing method. For this reason, a contract was established with LaserGrade that also began this month.

Practical examinations were held on September 10, 2007 at 101 East Capitol, Suite 106, in Little Rock. Written examinations were held across the state in locations convenient to the individual test-taker.
