In Section 2, 2.4(G), questions 6, 9, 13, 15, 20, 21, and several others are specific and exclusively used in the administration of self-funded health plans, currently all of which is managed by ABCBS. Many of these tools would be redundant and unnecessary if ABCBS or another TPA manages the plan ASO. If this is not the intent, we will need to modify our software development to Benefit Administration services and claims analysis, benchmarking, wellness optimization and similar services.
