The objective of this RFP is to obtain best value, and in some cases, achieve more favorable pricing, than are obtainable by an individual state or local government agency because of the collective volume of potential purchases by numerous state and local government entities. It is intended that the State's goal is to reduce print; therefore, as prints are reduced the cost for prints will remain the same.*
