For instance, is it anticipated the hardware secure youth will stay longer than the staff-secure youth?</p> <p>Answer: Length-of-stay (LOS) is determined based on the risk-level and needs of the individual youth, regardless of the facility to which the youth is assigned. In general, youth with higher-risk or higher-needs will stay longer than lower-risk/need youth. Programming at all facilities should be adaptable to these individual needs. DYS is currently developing more detailed LOS policy which aligns with research.</p> <p>We understand the research on LOS and the desire to keep youth only as long as needed complete treatment, yet want to align with DYS expectations.</p> <p>Answer: See Final RFP Item 6.5.A.1</p>
24	General	<p>Question:</p> <p>Are all four facilities currently PREA-, ACA-, and CARF-compliant (with respect to physical plant)?</p> <p>Answer: No.</p>

30	3.6	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 3.6 Vehicles, can you provide the number of vehicles currently in use at each facility?</p> <p>Answer: Yes</p> <p>Will those vehicles transition to the selected vendor?</p> <p>Answer: See Final RFP Item 3.4.A</p> <p>Or will the vendor need to lease/purchase?</p> <p>Answer: See Final RFP Item 3.6.</p>
31	4.2	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 4.2, what are the current security systems in place at each facility?</p> <p>Answer: Milestone camera systems are in place at each facility.</p>

32	4.4	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 4.4 Age Appropriate Services and Placement, Section A, Contractor shall ensure that all juveniles eighteen (18) years old or older have no interactive contact with any younger juveniles. Contractor may achieve this separation by age through time phasing of common use nonresidential areas. Contractor may seek exceptions to this requirement from DYS.</p> <p>Can we please have clarification on the expectations of youth separation by age, and clarification as to if this applies during education hours as well?</p> <p>Answer: See Final RFP Section 4.4 A.</p>
33	5.1.C	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 5.1.C., it references a "contracted education provider," giving the impression that an outside entity will be providing the school program.</p> <p>Answer: This question is not applicable for Prospective Contractor to submit a qualified proposal.</p> <p>Can we receive clarification on who this provider is and what are the specific education services they will be providing that are not the responsibility of the facility/program provider? Who currently provides education services at each facility?</p> <p>Answer: This question is not applicable for Prospective Contractor to submit a qualified proposal.</p>
34	5	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 5, it appears that the facility/program provider (not the contracted education provider referenced in 5.1.C.) is required to provide the Vocational Education, Special Education, and GED Preparation services, and employing Certified Teachers.</p> <p>Is this correct?</p> <p>Answer: Yes.</p>

36	6.2	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 6.2 Treatment Model, the Contractor shall utilize developmentally appropriate Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy as the operational treatment model. This model is built upon a Cognitive-Behavioral Treatment foundation.</p> <p>Given that the treatment modality is Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, is there requirement for the family to be involved in the weekly sessions and/or expectation for family involvement?</p> <p>Answer: Refer to Final RFP Section 6.14.</p>

37	6.3	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 6.3, who is the current provider for behavioral healthcare services at each facility?</p> <p>Answer: This question is not applicable for Prospective Contractor to submit a qualified proposal.</p>
38	6.4	<p>Question:</p> <p>Within Section 6.4 Clinical Staff Requirements, Section C., Contractor shall ensure therapists are supervised by a licensed psychiatrist.</p> <p>What are the expectations for the supervision of the licensed psychiatrist over the therapists?</p> <p>Answer: Only clinical supervision is required.</p> <p>Is it just for clinical supervision (case consultation, treatment discussions, recommendations) typically for one hour a week?</p> <p>Answer: Only clinical supervision is required.</p> <p>Or is it for full clinical and administrative oversight?</p> <p>Answer: Only clinical supervision is required.</p>

51	Price Sheet	<p>Question:</p> <p>Cost Sheet-Can you please clarify the medical treatment line item? There appears to be no subsection 6.15.</p> <p>Answer: See RFP Attachment - Final SP-19-0054 Official Bid Price Sheet.</p>
52	Subcontractors	<p>Question:</p> <p>Subcontractors-Can you please clarify and define what you mean by subcontractors?</p> <p>Answer: See Final RFP Item 1.5.J</p> <p>Is this strictly for direct services to youth? Or for overall facility vendors (pest control, food services, etc)?</p> <p>Answer: Overall facility vendors. Upon approval by DYS, Contractor may subcontract any services in the scope of work.</p>
