Cancellation of contract if certification is not maintained. A possible "Below Standard" rating on the State Quarterly Vendor Performance Report.
The candidate has a current unrestricted DEA permit.	Provide current DEA permit	Cancellation of contract if permit is not maintained. A possible "Below Standard" rating on the State Quarterly Vendor Performance Report.
The candidate is able to successfully pass a back ground check and a drug screen.	100% compliance.	Cancellation of contract if unable to pass back ground check and drug screen. A possible "Below Standard" rating on the State Quarterly Vendor Performance Report.
The candidate has experience with electronic medical records.	Discussion by candidate of EMR usage.	A possible "Below Standard" rating on the State Quarterly Vendor Performance Report.
