## ARKANSAS WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD

### AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT INTEGRATED SETTING

#### 1. PURPOSE

It shall be the policy of the Arkansas Workforce Investment Board to ensure an integrated setting for individuals with physical disabilities in all facilities owned, leased, or utilized by the administrative entities of the Workforce Investment Act. It is the intent of this Board that all individuals are assured of an equal opportunity in employment and access to service through a barrier free environment.

#### 2. SCOPE

This policy applies to all facilities owned, leased, or utilized by the administrative entities operating under the Workforce Investment Act for the provision of service, either direct or in a support role.

#### 3. RESPONSIBILITIES

It shall be the responsibility of the Local Workforce Investment Board to develop a system to assure enforcement of this policy, that at a minimum:

37.7(d) – All recipients of WIA Title I-financially assisted programs and activities in the most integrated setting appropriate to the needs of qualified individuals with disabilities.

The recipient must provide programs or activities in a setting that enables individuals with disabilities to interact with non-disabled persons to the fullest extent possible.
