Subject: American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, Workforce Investment Act Title I – Youth, Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities Subgrant Award Numbers, Funding Amounts and Funding Requirements

1. **Purpose:** To provide American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA), Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Title I – Youth, Adult and Dislocated Worker Activities subgrant award numbers, funding amounts and funding requirements to local workforce investment areas.

2. **General Information:**

- This Issuance provides ARRA subgrant award numbers, funding amounts, and funding requirements for all three funding streams. For all three funding streams, the performance period for your subgrant awards will be February 17, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

➤ **Note:** Page number 25 of TEGL 14-08 is inaccurate in stating, “Local areas will have until the end of PY 2010 (June 30, 2011) to expend WIA Youth Recovery Act funds.” This was confirmed by DOL during the youth conference call that took place on Wednesday, March 25, 2009.

The WIA Regulations state:

§ 667.107(b) Grant funds expended by local areas.

§ 667.107(b)(1) Funds allocated by a State to a local area under WIA sections 128(b) and 133(b), for any program year are available for expenditure only during that program year and the succeeding program year.

-Over-

§ 667.107(b)(2) Funds which are not expended by a local area in the two-year period described in paragraph (b)(1) of this section, must be returned to the State. Funds so

returned are available for expenditure by State and local recipients and subrecipients only during the third program year of availability. These funds may:

§ 667.107(b) (2) (i) Be used for Statewide projects, or

§ 667.107(b) (2) (ii) Be distributed to other local areas which had fully expended their allocation of funds for the same program year within the two-year period.

We are awaiting further guidance from DOL relative to options that may be made available to states and local areas in terms of statutory recapture requirements.
