

Mr. Johnny Lee Morgan, age 73, of Colt, died Monday afternoon, January 25, 2016, in Memphis, Tennessee. Born August 19, 1942, he was the son of Preston Morgan and Alice Kay Morgan. He was a veteran of the US Army, served in VietNam, and an Agent Orange Survivor. He served as local Commander of the VFW and American Legion. He attended Arkansas State University, and Dallas Institute of Mortuary Science. He was co-founder of Morgan Funeral Home in Forrest City and worked as owner funeral director until 1986. He also worked at several funeral home across Arkansas prior to retiring to Colt and purchasing Davidson Traylor Park where he resided. He was a member of the Beckspur Baptist Church.
