19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-26-412 is amended to read as follows:  
22 17-26-412. School term – Cosmetology curriculum.

23 (a) Every school shall maintain a school term of not less than one  
24 thousand five hundred (1,500) hours, instruction of which shall not be in  
25 excess of ~~eight (8)~~ ten (10) hours per day and six (6) days per week during  
26 the course. The school shall maintain a course of practical training and  
27 technical instruction equal to the requirements for examination for a license  
28 as a cosmetologist.

29 (b) It shall so arrange the courses devoted to each branch or practice  
30 of cosmetology as the State Board of Cosmetology may from time to time adopt  
31 as the course to be followed by the schools.
