We recall some confusion about the interchangeability of the words "shall" and "must" in a previous State RFP. Are the words in fact interchangeable and both meant to communicate an requirement as absolute?	Yes.
2	Sec. 2.5.H	"The Contractor shall use a systems architecture where the playout server, automation system and associated video switching, and file storage resides on site at AR-PBS and the four (4) Master Control feeds are originated locally."	The systems architecture of our centralized master control service is one where our automation, storage, and playout hardware is operated and resides at our hub location. May we assume that the current wording of this question rejects providers using this architecture?	See RFP Section 1.5.
3	Sec. 2.5.H	"The Contractor shall use a systems architecture where the playout server, automation system and associated video switching, and file storage resides on site at AR-PBS and the four (4) Master Control feeds are originated locally."	If the answer to Question 2 above is yes, may we appeal for an amendment to Sec. 2.5.H to consider any proven architecture?
